Subject : Recruitment for the post of Assistant Professors in the various Dental Specialty in the pay matrix level-11 Rs. 67,700/- to Rs. 2,08,700/- on Regular Basis.

In continuation of the notice dated 30/03/2026 regarding subject cited above, the Institution is in receipt of various queries from the applicants regarding the forthcoming written examination for the post of Assistant Professors (Dental). The clarifications are listed as follows -

Only those candidates who are residing outside Delhi may collect their Admit Card from Examination Centre on the day of examination up-to 12:00 P.M/Noon only.

OBC candidate must be from GNCT of Delhi with valid non creamy layer certificate.

Ratio in papers in the forthcoming written examination for the post of Assistant Professors (Dental). 25% of the questions will be of Basic Sciences and remaining 75% of the questions shall pertain to the specialty in which applicant has done MDS.

However, out of the total number of qualified candidates in written test, only those candidates shall be called for interview, who fall within the merit of not be more than 3 times the number of vacancies.

Verification of documents of documents in respect of candidates short listed for interview shall be undertaken after declaration of result on 4th June, 2026.

As already informed vide Notice dated 30th May, 2026 it is again reiterated that all provisionally allowed candidates will have to produce their original certificates, especially in respect of their respective experience that should be backed by documents issued by erstwhile Dental Council of India/ National Dental Council [whichever is applicable] in respect of valid teaching experience certificate, failing which his/her candidature shall be rejected without affording any further opportunity.

The tentative date for conduct of interview is 5th June, 2026 [Confirmation of same shall be notified shortly]

Persons short listed for interview in 'Periodontic Department' are hereby informed that in pursuance of an ongoing matter sub-judice in the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi in Writ Petition No.4978/2026 vide order dated 15th April, 2026 the Hon'ble Court has ordered as follows – "..... 6. It is accordingly directed that any appointment made to the post of Assistant Professor (Periodontics), pursuant to the advertisement dated 30th March, 2026, shall be subject to

the outcome of the present proceedings. The candidate selected pursuant to the aforesaid recruitment process shall be informed in writing of the present order, so as to enable such candidate totake an informed decision regarding joining the post in question....”.

NOTE :

- 1) Candidates are requested to bring their latest passport size photograph along-with original Photo ID proof issued by Govt. agency like Passport, Aadhar Card, Driving License, Voter I Card etc. at the time of collection/receiving of “ADMIT CARD”. In case the candidate fails to present the photograph and original Photo ID proof, his/her admit card will not be issued;
- 2) Candidates are again advised not to write anything on the admit card or on its hind side, which will render the cancellation of their candidature and candidates are further advised to strictly refrain from any kind of malafide activities during examination that can also lead to cancellation of their examination.
