Manual I Particulars of Organization, functions and duties (Section 4(1)(b)(i)

A new era in Dental Education and Research was ushered on 26th Sept. 2003 with the inauguration of nine storied building constructed at the estimated cost of 16 crores for Maulana Azad Dental College & Hospital. This premier Dental Institute of the capital has been given a full-fledged independent status by Govt. of Delhi vide order No. F.202-DC&H/2002-2003/2503 dated 4.7.2003. Further the Lt. Governor of the GNCT of Delhi orders of development of existing Maulana Azad Dental College and Hospital, New Delhi as a center of excellence for Dental care, teaching training and research and its management as an autonomous body, through a society named as the Maulana Azad Institute of Dental Sciences vide notification No.F.400(41)/2002/H&FW(Plg.)/624 dated Ist July – 2005.

This teaching and Research Institute is only one of its kind in Delhi, dedicated to providing Comprehensive Oral, Dental and Maxillofacial health care services as well as under graduate training. The dedicated designated roll of the college is:-

- 1. Teaching and training of BDS under graduate students, Junior Residents (Dental) Post Graduate (MDS) Students and Senior Residents (Dental) in different dental specialties.
- 2. Catering to burgeoning patient load: Due to growing awareness about oral and dental health amongst masses, there has been a marked increase in the number of patients visiting dental OPD and various dental specialty departments over the years. In 1999-2000 around 5000 patients attended dental OPD and dental speciality clinics. By 2003-04 this number has increase to more than 1250 patients per day.
- 3. Multi speciality dental treatment to cases referred by dental departments of All India Institute of Medical Sciences, Ram Manohar Lohia Hospital, Lady Harding Medical College & Hospital and Dental establishment of neighboring cities in NCR region.
- 4. Undertake service oriented research projects.

INFRASTRUCTURE

Maulana Azad Institute of Dental Sciences is a busy multi-specialty tertiary care Institution of excellence and has 9 specialty departments namely:

Prosthodontics
Conservative dentistry
Periodontics
Pedodontics

Orthodontics

Oral & Maxillofacial surgery Oral diagnosis & Radiology Community Dentistry Oral Pathology.

Each department has provision for dental chair unit system with all the requisite equipments for pre-clinical dental training and basic sciences as recommended by the Dental Council of India.

Each specialty has a separate floor with a separate clinical area for under graduate and postgraduate students. The floor wise location is as follows:-

MAIDS has a functional department library with copies of relevant books and journals. In addition a central library also exists within the main building of MAMC Complex. In addition to books and journals in the library, internet CDs, audiovisual facilities also exist. All the journals of all the specialties and allied subjects are being made available as per budgetary allocation.

 - (ii) ORAL SURGERY & MAXILLOFACIAL SURGERY: Treatment of fracture, trauma and emergency, Indoor- Outdoor facility, OT facility with intensive care unit.
 - (iii) <u>PROSTHODONTICS:</u> All artificial, complete and partial, fixed and removable prosthesis, artificial facial prosthesis for oral for patients and implants.

- (iv) <u>CONSERVATIVE DENTISTRY:</u> Restorative esthetic dentistry, and endodontic treatment.
- (v) <u>ORTHODONTICS</u>:- Correction of mal-aligned teeth, dentofacial anamolies including cleft lip and plate.
- (vi) <u>PEDODONTICS DENTISTRY</u>:- Pediatric dentistry all dental work related to children including council ling.
- (vii) <u>PERIODONTICS: -</u> Treatment of all gum diseases, periodental regenerate surgery splitting and implants.
- (viii) ORAL PATHOLOGY: Histological/Biochemistry examination of specimens.
- (ix) <u>COMMUNITY DENTISTRY</u>:- All community related work being done by Community Dentistry Department.
 - About 1250 patients are daily getting treatment in the Hospital.
